

SOUTH BUCKS ARCHERS "252" IMPROVEMENT AWARD

The 252 award is designed to help you practice your shooting at different distances and recognise your achievements. After 6 sighters, you will shoot 3 dozen arrows on a 122cm face at your chosen distance. The round can be shot at 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 80 or 100 yds with the aim of scoring 252 or better (alternative scores apply for other bow types. See table below)

The Rules:

- Six sighters to be followed immediately by three dozen scored arrows.
- 5-zone scoring (Gold = 9, Red = 7, Blue = 5, Black = 3, White = 1) using a 122cm target face.
- The three dozen arrows must be shot as a 252 round and not as part of a longer round.
- Badges must be claimed in sequence starting with 20y
- To claim an award, show your completed, signed and witnessed scoresheet to Sue. Badges cost £2 each.

- The awards are as follows:

The 252 Scheme is not designed to take people away from shooting the recognised rounds and it will not count towards your handicap or classification. It is designed to help members gain confidence in shooting longer distances, whilst at the same time recognising their achievement with the award of a badge. Do keep in mind that the maximum score for 36 arrows when using 5 zone scoring is 324, so 252 is quite a challenge! Good shooting and good luck!
